What to Bring Fishing

Clothing:

-Be sure to carry at least one change of clothing for both hot and cold temperatures.

(It is common for the temperature to fluctuate from 44°F to 95°F daily. Water temperature is typically around 55°F.)

- -When hiking, proper footwear is a must, and must be durable and comfortable.
- -Avoid cotton if possible
- -Rain gear
- -Hat

Rigging:

Although we have rods available for use, many clients prefer their own. The following is suggested gear.

4-8 Weight

10Lb break strength

Leader (3-6x)

Tippet (3-6x)
